



### Mountains, Water, City 靈山・秀水・名城



The Chinese expression for "natural landscape" is *shan shui* – translated as "mountains water". The phrase describes Hong Kong perfectly, given its ranges and coasts, ravines and valleys, bays and islands. In few other places does such countryside exist so close to a busy city. Newcomers are always amazed by Hong Kong's enticing natural beauty and scenic grandeur, a unique asset for both nature and man.

Majestic Lamma Island, seen above, epitomizes Hong Kong's green aspect. Even on Hong Kong Island, on its northern side densely crowded and with a global business hub, there are lush valley woodlands. Rugged peaks divide Hong Kong Island; bays and peninsulas form its indented southern coast; and in the east jagged headlands plunge into the sea. Further afield, in the extensive New Territories, are still wilder areas. In many places these are totally uninhabited and often breathtakingly beautiful. Easily accessible hiking trails cross scenic ranges; descend to remote coasts; pass old stone-walled villages – all amidst subtropical native flora, fauna and marine biodiversity.

「山水」二字意指自然風景,這個詞語是香港最貼切的寫照。這兒山脈綿亙,倚抱着谿壑幽谷,海灣及海島競艷,山光水色令人神往。 環顧世界,沒有幾個繁忙都會像香港這樣與郊野依偎。初到香港的 人無不被她奇偉的山水勝景深深吸引,這份得天獨厚的寶藏對大自然 和人類同樣重要。

上圖的南丫島姿態雄偉,可說是香港綠野的最佳縮影。在香港島,儘管北部是樓字鱗次櫛比的國際商業中心,但其他部份仍保留着蒼巒和秀谷。香港島有多座高山形成天然的分界線,南面的海灣及半島曲折多姿,東面的岬角岩石嶙峋,迎海而立。距離港島較遠的新界地域廣闊,仍有不少原始郊野,許多更是無人居住且風景絕美。香港的遠足徑網絡四通八達,跨越崇山峻嶺到達偏遠海岸,沿途經過古樸的石牆圍村,充滿鄉郊風情,還有多樣性的香港原生亞熱帶動植物和海洋生物作伴。

### THE PHOTOGRAPHIC HERITAGE FOUNDATION 歷史遺珍攝影基金會

The Photographic Heritage Foundation's objectives grew from those of a previous organization. This was the Hong Kong Conservation Photography Foundation (1997 – 2008). The body was tasked with publishing nature landscape photographs, to encourage conservation and with advocacy for environmental issues. "HKCPF" was inspired by the mission, photo books and calendars of the Australian Conservation Foundation. Since 1997 – 2008, when this calendar's photos were taken, the Hong Kong urban areas have changed greatly. Yet its countryside remains virtually unchanged.

The Photographic Heritage Foundation itself was established in 2008. It is a Hong Kong not-for-profit body and Charitable Institution. The Foundation's objective is to present Asia's photographic heritage. Thus, it is a bridge between rare, often forgotten historical photos of Asia and those interested in the region's cultural heritage. The photographs that the Foundation seeks out and publishes hold up a mirror to rapidly changing societies. In partnership with sponsors, the body originates books, exhibitions and online content.

歷史遺珍攝影基金會承傳其前身「香港自然環境攝影基金會」(1997 – 2008年)的使命目標,致力出版自然風景影集,藉此促進保育及倡導大眾正視環境議題。香港自然環境攝影基金會受到 Australian Conservation Foundation的使命、影集和月曆所啟迪而成立,該會於1997至2008年營運期間,亦即拍攝本幀月曆所載照片的時期,香港市區改頭換面,然而郊區則幾乎沒有改變。

歷史遺珍攝影基金會是 2008 年在香港成立的非牟利及慈善機構。基金會的目的是擔當橋樑角色,將被人遺忘的亞洲逝影公諸於世,獻給關心地區文化歷史的讀者鑑賞分享。本會努力搜羅及出版攝影作品,透過影像敘事,反映各地社會的急促變化。在贊助機構的熱心支持下,基金會出版書籍和舉辦展覽及網上傳訊。

### NATURE AND MARINE CONSERVATION 自然與海洋保育



Surely remarkably – for so small a place – well over half of Hong Kong's 1,108 square kilometre land area is countryside. Of the total area, some forty percent is conserved in twenty-four Country Parks. Eleven other high biodiversity sites are also protected. Around the coasts, six areas are conserved as Marine Parks and one as a Marine Reserve.

The government's Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department ensures all these areas' benefits. One of its great successes is reforestation, bringing the resurgence of native flora habitats and so growing populations of native fauna. The reforestation was pioneered many decades ago by planting hardy exotic species – like the Australian paperbark tree above.

Marine conservation is focused on the Cape D'Aguilar Marine Reserve, site of The Swire Institute of Marine Science. At beautiful Kadoorie Farm and Botanic Garden, the study and protection of native flora and fauna is accompanied by holistic, ecological and sustainability education. In the west, the Mai Po Nature Reserve's wetlands are a haven for tens of thousands of migratory waterbirds. In the east, the Hong Kong UNESCO Global Geopark has dramatic volcanic rock columns.

香港這個蕞爾之地面積僅1,108平方公里,但逾半範圍是自然郊野。 香港大概四成土地劃為24個郊野公園,另有11個生物多樣性豐富的 地區亦受法例保護,沿岸則有六個海岸公園和一個海岸保護區。

香港政府轄下的漁農自然護理署的職責是保障及孕育這些保護地區, 而植林就是署方最顯赫的成就之一。在其努力下,香港紛繁的原生 植物生境漸漸重現,原生動物種群亦健康繁衍。香港的植林工作已有 數十年歷史,早年種植外來品種,例如上圖的澳洲白千層。

香港大學太古海洋科學研究所位處的鶴咀海岸保護區是香港的海洋 保育工作基地;風景優美的嘉道理農場暨植物園則從事本地動植物 研究保育和推廣全人、生態及可持續發展教育;西部的米埔自然保護 區擁有濕地生境,是成千上萬遷飛水鳥的棲息地;至於新界東部則有 香港聯合國教科文組織世界地質公園,展示壯偉非凡的火山岩柱。

### Edward Stokes 艾思滔

Edward Stokes is an Australian photographer and writer. He grew up in Hong Kong and in 1993 returned there to work on photographic projects. His special interest today is preserving the photographic history of Asia – especially that of Hong Kong. Previously, for two decades – in both Hong Kong and Australia – he had focused on his own nature landscape photography. Today the Founder and Publisher of The Photographic Heritage Foundation, Edward's numerous books on Hong Kong and Australia have been praised for integrating photos with illuminating nature and historical texts.

This calendar's photos are from Olympus 35mm and Pentax 67 camera transparencies. Always indirectly, and often directly, these photos were visually led by Stokes' 1980s photographs taken across Australia. Those, in turn, had been inspired by the images of two Tasmanian conservation photographers, Olegas Truchanas and Peter Dombrovskis. Edward Stokes' first Hong Kong nature conservation book, *Hong Kong's Wild Places* (1995), translated as *Shan Shui Yau Ching* (2000), remains a definitive account of the local setting. The work portrays, over the millennia and recent centuries, Hong Kong's natural and man-made landscape changes.

澳洲攝影師兼作家艾思滔兒時在香港長大,1993年回港發展,先後完成多項攝影計劃,現時以保護亞洲歷史照片為工作重點,其對香港的攝影遺珍尤其關注。過去二十年,艾思滔在香港和澳洲均專注於個人攝影,用鏡頭捕捉當地的自然景致,今天則擔任歷史遺珍攝影基金會的創辦人及出版人,在香港和澳洲撰著的出色作品眾多,收錄的照片引人入勝,文字極具啟發性,呈獻區內的自然風貌與歷史。

本幀月曆的照片以奧林巴斯 35毫米及賓得 67 相機菲林拍攝,視覺 構圖有意無意間呼應着艾思滔於 1980年代在澳洲各地獵拍的作品, 那批作品的靈感來自兩位塔斯曼尼亞保育攝影師 Olegas Truchanas 和 Peter Dombrovskis。 Hong Kong's Wild Places (1995年)是艾思滔第 一本以香港自然保育為題的著作,其後推出中文翻譯版《山水有情》 (2000年),迄今仍被公認為香港環境的詳實記敘,細說從遠古到近 代香港自然郊野及人工環境如何變遷演進。








